MAJOR ACHIEVEMENTS

1. THE ESTABLISHMENT OF RAJIV GANDHI POLYTECHNIC AT ITANAGAR UNDER TECH ED-III PROJECT OF MHRD ASSISTED BY THE WORLD BANK:

It was an opportunity given by the state government on me as Project Manager to implement a time bound project (2001-2007) for establishment of the first professional polytechnic in Arunachal Pradesh. And with the full support of the state government, the Rajiv Gandhi Govt. Polytechnic, Itanagar was successfully implemented within the time bound project. It was really an achievement for the state.

The establishment of this polytechnic also inspired for establishment of the Tomi Polytechnic at Basar through privately managed. Our constant advise has helped Tomi Polytechnic to develop into a full pledge Institute now.

2. STUDY TOUR TO GERMANY:

To get first hand knowledge of existing technical institute in foreign countries by the implementation agencies a study tour, to Germany was organized by MHRD, I was one of the participants in the tour.

The study team first visited and attended meeting at BMBF (Federal Ministry of Education and Research at Bonn), BIBB (Federal Institute of Vocational Training, Bonn). The team next head for Aachen and visited IKA (Institute of Autonomous System of RWTH, Aachen), Faachhochschule Aachen(University of Applied Science) , visited Mase. Eyth Schule, (STUTT GART), Daimlet Chrysler Centre at Sendelfongem (The factory of MERCES BENZ). There was also good session of discussion with the professors and student of Karlshure, University of Technology (FACHHOCHSCHULE), Fachhochschule is the university for modern Industrial Society. In this university the COMMITTEE FOR CONTINUING EDUCATION, which offer interested parties, the full range of services within a single facility also exist.

We also interacted with the students and resource person of Brefsakademie-The University of Cooperative Education.

The CARL BENZ at schule at Baden WITTEN BURG were also visited. At KOLN (COLOGNE) visited the house of BEETHOVEN, the great composer of music.

20 girls and 20 boys along with Programme Officer came from each Universities. This camp gave exposure to the student of other state on Arunachal Pradesh. It is an achievement because till date NIC of that magnitude has not been repeated in the state.
